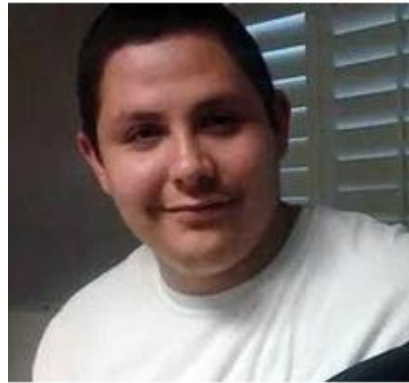


Kickapoo Reservation, KS
