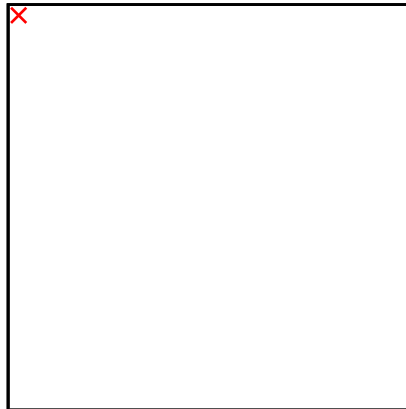


Centralia , KS
