(KLZA) Charges are pending against two juveniles following reports of two stolen pickups in Humboldt on Saturday, October 26th. The Richardson County Sheriff's Office is investigating the theft of the two pickups.

The Chevy dually truck owned by Eric Eden was later recovered in Nemaha County, Nebraska near the intersection of Highways 67 and 105 by a Nemaha County Sheriff's Deputy. The pickup was impounded for processing by the Richardson County Sheriff's Office. The S-10 was returned to the owner.
