Nemaha NRD Board Increases Electric Hook-up Fees (KTNC) - Campers will have to pay a little more to connect their RVs to electricity at a couple Nemaha NRD parks.

The NRD Board of Directors has approved an increase in for campsites with electrical hook-ups from \$10 to \$12 per night at Kirkman's Cove Recreation Area and Iron Horse Trail Lake. The increase is effective January 1.

The increased rates will allow the district to maintain the sites and recoup the cost of the electricity.

There will be no increase for vehicle entry permits, which are required at the parks in addition to the electrical hook-up fees.

The NRD Board to the action during its meeting last week.

In other business, the board approved ten permits for irrigation wells. Permits were approved for four landowners in Richardson County, two in Johnson County, and one in Otoe County.
