The Nemaha County Commission on Monday accepted a bid from Hall Brothers of Marysville to overlay the Goff-Oneida Road this summer at a cost of \$1.1 million.

Sheriff Rich Vernon presented bids from three dealerships. The commission voted to accept the low bid from Nemaha Valley Motors in Seneca for the purchase of 2014 Dodge Charger at a cost of \$18,000 with the trade-in of a 2010 Dodge Charger with more than 100,000 miles.
