Jury Trials Set for Holton Man in Two Cases (KNZA)--Jury trials have been set for a Holton man facing charges in two separate cases.

During a hearing Friday, Jackson County Attorney Shawna Miller says a February 3rd jury trial was set for 33-year-old Bradley Stanley Sr. on a charge of aggravated battery. Stanley is accused of assaulting another inmate in the Jackson County Jail in August.

In the other case, Miller says a jury trial was set for February 18th-20th on charges stemming from the alleged sexual battery of a 16-year-old Hoyt girl in July. Stanley is charged with aggravated sexual battery, aggravated burglary, vehicular burglary and theft in connection with that incident.

He pleaded "not guilty" to charges in both cases earlier this month.
