Law Enforcement Agreement Approved by SE Neb Board (KLZA)-- The Nemaha County, Nebraska Commissioners met Wednesday.

Commissioners approved an interlocal agreement between the County, Nemaha County Sheriff's Office and City of Auburn for the Sheriff's office to provide law enforcement services to the City of Auburn. The cost to the City of Auburn will increase from \$283,000 to \$306,000 due to increases in salaries, health insurance and other expenses. The new agreement goes into effect January 1.
