Horton Man Sentenced in Reservation Fight

(KNZA)--A rural Horton man convicted on charges in connection with a fight in October that left one man injured on the Kickapoo Reservation has been placed on 24-months supervised probation.

48-year-old Robert Winsea was sentenced Monday in Brown County District Court on charges of aggravated battery and domestic battery.

Winsea pleaded "no contest" to the charges in December. In exchange for the plea, an additional count of domestic battery was dismissed.

Sentencing for a co-defendant in the case, 21-year-old rural Horton resident Robert Savago, was postponed Monday to February 23rd on a charge of aggravated battery.

The two men were charged in connection with a fight on October 25th at a residence on the Kickapoo Reservation that injured Aaron Savago. He required hospitalized treatment.
