### Centennial Scholarships Available to Richardson County Students

(KLZA)-- Applications for the annual Richardson County Bank & Trust Company Centennial Scholarships have been mailed to Richardson County High Schools. The Guidance Counselors at Falls City, Sacred Heart and HTRS Schools have them.

Richardson County Bank offers two \$1,400 scholarships to graduating seniors from any of the three Richardson County high schools who plan to continue their education at an accredited four-year college or University beginning in the fall of 2015.
