Coin Flip Determines Reserve Mayor's Race

(KNZA)--A coin flip has determined the new mayor of the Brown County community of Reserve. Brandon Ruch was declared the winner following the coin flip during Monday's Brown County Commission meeting.

It was needed to break a tie after a canvass of votes last week from the April 7th election ended with incumbent Janice Sanders and Ruch each receiving 13 votes.

Price accepted the mayor's position, and Halstead will serve on the City Council. Both men had also been elected to the Council. The Council will have to appoint someone to fill Price's council position.
