Atchison Area Chamber of Commerce President Jacque Pregont says there was a community effort to keep the store open, when it almost closed three years ago, that was led by Roger Caudle. She adds that "obviously, we never want anyone to close, we hate the whole idea of anyone closing their doors, it's just really sad. I think it's too bad that we were not supportive enough to keep them here."

Eaton says no final date has been set for the store's closing.
