Law Enforcement Memorial Planned in Holt County MO.

(Mound City)-- The intersection of Missouri Highways 111 and 118 in Holt County will be the site of a Law Enforcement Memorial wall.

According to the Mound City News, the wall is scheduled to be built this summer on land donated by Mr. & Mrs. Donald Tubbs to honor local law enforcement officers who have lost their lives in the line of duty.

Tentative plans are for a dedication ceremony on August 2. The memorial wall will include parking and will have handicap accessible ramps.
