New Hiawatha Leadership Sworn In (KNZA)--The City of Hiawatha officially has a new Mayor, and City Commissioner.

City Clerk Vivian Constable administered the Oath of Office to Steffen Shamburg as Mayor at the beginning of Monday evening's City Commission meeting. John Sheeran was then sworn as the new Commissioner of Police following his appointment to fill Shamburg's former seat.
