The Board approved a letter of support for the three-year plan as developed.

Board members approved posting notice of the District 1 Road Department vacant foreman's position, and voted to declare a 1996 John Deer excavator as surplus equipment, authorizing the county clerk to advertise for sealed bids to be opened July 1.

Sheriff Brent Lottman was authorized to negotiate for a tract of land to be used for a communications tower site. Commissioners also voted not to purchase an additional \$2-million liability policy form NIRMA for three county owned dams.

Quotes were received for a new HVAC system for the District 1 Count Barn with the quote from Auburn Plumbing & Heating for a 100,000 BTU Reznor Radiant Tube/Heater in an amount of \$2,530 approved.
