Father & Son Arrested for Alleged Marijuana Growing Operation

Both men were booked into the Jackson County Jail on charges of cultivating a controlled substance, possession of hallucinogenic drugs and possession of drug paraphernalia. Bond for each was set Thursday at \$35,000.
