

**Search Warrants Land Four In Jail**

**(KNZA)--Two search warrants, served in the Holton area Wednesday evening, lead to the arrest of four for alleged crimes ranging from drug possession to explosives charges.**

**Jackson County Sheriff Tim Morse says the first raid took place at 221 Dakota Avenue, in Holton, around 5:00.**

**It was there that 52-year-old Kirk Teske, 51-year-old Steven Donahue, and 46-year-old Marjorie Heim were taken into custody.**

**All three Holton residents were booked into the Jackson County Jail.**

**Teske faces charges including possession of methamphetamine, possession of marijuana, drug paraphernalia, and domestic battery.**

**Donahue and Heim both face charges including possession of meth, marijuana and drug paraphernalia.**

**Morse says the second search warrant as executed around 7:00 Wednesday evening at 12349 244th Lane, north of Holton.**

**Arrested at the scene was 51-year-old Randy Hyatt Sr.**

**The Holton resident was taken into custody on charges including possession of methamphetamine and criminal use of an explosive device.**

**All four suspects were booked into the Jackson County Jail.**
