

3 Students Among Four Killed in Wreck

**(KNZA)--Four people were killed, including three students from the Silver Lake School District, in a two-vehicle wreck on U.S. 24 Highway east of Silver Lake Thursday morning.**

**The Kansas Highway Patrol says a car driven by 17-year-old high school senior Devin Greeve was westbound when the vehicle crossed the center line and was struck in the passenger side by an eastbound car driven by 47-year-old Rossville resident Lance Lenard.**

**Greeve and two passengers in his vehicle, 11-year-old 6th grader Gaby Greeve and 14-year-old freshman Tyler Crouse were killed. The Patrol says all three were from Topeka.**

**Lenard, who served as head coach of the Northeast Kansas Track Club, also died in the collision. A passenger in his vehicle, his 13-year-old son, Kade, was transported to a Topeka hospital where he was reported in stable condition.**

**The wreck was reported shortly before 7:30.**
