

Arraignment Postponed in Sabetha Standoff Case

**(KMZA)--The arraignment for a Sabetha man charged in connection with a five-hour armed standoff in Sabetha in March has been pushed back.**

**The arraignment for 50-year-old James McKenney had been scheduled for Monday in Nemaha County District Court, but the Nemaha County Attorney's office says it was continued to the morning of September 15th.**

**McKenney is charged with aggravated assault, two counts of criminal threat, interference with law enforcement, possession of methamphetamine, possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia.**

**He remains in the Nemaha County Jail, held on a \$250,000 bond.**
