

USD 115 Board Approves BackSnack Program

**(KMZA)--The Nemaha Central USD 115 Board of Education has given their approval to a program that provides weekend meals for children.**

**The Board Monday evening heard a presentation from Nemaha Central Elementary and Middle School Early Childhood Special Education teacher Jamie Anderson on the Harvesters BackSnack program.**

**Nemaha County is located within the Harvesters 26-county service area in northwest Missouri and northeast Kansas.**

**The food is free and is distributed through the local food bank.**

**Anderson requested permission to complete the requirements needed to implement the program in the elementary & middle school. One requirement is that the superintendent submit a letter of support authorizing the food bank to operate within the district.**

**The Board voted unanimously to authorize Superintendent Darrel Kohlman to write a letter of support allowing the food bank to operate within the district.**
