

Two to Share Sheriff's Investigator Title

**(KMZA)--Two current Nemaha County Sheriff's deputies will share the title of investigator.**

**Sheriff Rich Vernon informed the Nemaha County Commission this week that he plans to have Josh Winkler and Jerry Birdsley share the position.**

**Both will be given a 50 an hour raise for assuming the extra duties, which became effective October 21st.**

**Steve Linden, who had held the position of investigator, retired in September of last year.**

**Vernon also informed the Commission of several other new hires.**

**He says he's hired Alishia Hynek, of Seneca, to fill a vacant full-time corrections officer position. Hynek will begin work October 30th at a salary of \$13.01 an hour.**

**Vernon also said he has hired Whitney Weaver, of Seneca, to fill an open full-time dispatcher position, effective October 30th. She had served as a relief dispatcher.**

**In addition, Vernon says he's hired Chris Mooney as a relief corrections officer. Mooney has already begun work.**
