

Face coverings required in Auburn

**(KLZA)--In an effort to slow down the spread of COVID-19 in the community of Auburn, Mayor Dan White signed a proclamation Wednesday requiring the use of face masks in indoor public spaces.**

**Face coverings will not be required for an individual under the age of five, an individual seated at a restaurant while eating or drinking, individuals exercising in an indoor facility while the level of exertion makes it difficult to wear face coverings provided the minimum social distancing of 6 feet is maintained and individuals that cannot otherwise wear face coverings due to a medical condition, mental health condition or a disability among other exemptions.**

**The proclamation is in effect until it can be reviewed at the next Auburn City Council meeting, which will take place on the evening of December 14th at 7:00 at City Hall.**
