

Masks will continue to be worn in Falls City Schools

(KLZA)--Current public health guidelines and the most recent DHM for schools in Nebraska remain mostly unchanged.

Falls City Public Schools will continue to follow the health recommendations of the Southeast District Health Department's public health guidelines for masking, social distancing and hand hygiene.
