Maude Mae (Poteet) Sejkora, 96 of Burchard, Nebraska passed away on Wednesday, September 21, 2016 at Gold Crest in Adam, Nebraska. Maude continued living on the farm until 2014 when she moved to Platte City, Missouri with her daughter and husband. The last few years were spent in Adams at the Gold Crest Retirement Center.

Maude was a member of the Order of the Eastern Star, the Worthwhile Extension Club, and the Burchard Methodist Church. She taught many years of Sunday School, held several offices in Club and Eastern Star. Maude worked

many years as an area contributor for the Pawnee Republican. She was an accomplished seamstress, making clothes for herself and her three daughters-from every day dresses and school clothes to costumes for plays, cheer leading skirts, prom dresses and bridesmaid dresses. Maude also made quilts. She made each of her kids a doubled sized quilt and made 40 plus baby quilts, many sets of dish towels and pillow cases. Maude sold Avon for the area for a few years during the kids' early years. After Shorty's death, Maude filled some of her long days working for Patty Stake at her store in Pawnee.
