Elijah Ray Junior Edmonds, 81, of Schuyler, Nebraska was born on November 15, 1936, in Peru, Nebraska to Elijah Buel and Lula Loretta (Seivers) Edmonds. He was raised in the Auburn area and attended Brock High School. On November 30, 1954, Elijah enter active duty in the U.S. Army and served his country during the Korean Conflict. He was honorably discharged on November 29, 1957 at Fort Lewis, Washington. In 1961, Elijah was united in marriage to Patricia Moore in Sidney, Iowa.
