Leona Eileen (Boeding) Olberding, 83, of Seneca, Kansas passed away on Friday, May 24, 2019 at Life Care Center of Seneca.

Leona was born east of Kelly, KS on December 13, 1935 to Herman and Anna (Haverkamp) Boeding. Leona graduated 8th grade from St. Bede's Catholic School. After her school years, she worked the family farm and helped women in the area during the time of their pregnancies. Leona also worked in Kansas City at various ice cream and candy shops during her early adult years.

On December 31, 1953 she married Robert Olberding at St. Bede's Catholic Church in Kelly, Kansas. When Robert entered the army, they were stationed at Fort Chaffee, Arkansas and then in Fort Lewis, Washington. In 1995 Robert and Leona purchased the original Olberding homestead west of Seneca where they retired.

Leona was active in the St. Ann's and St. Patrick's Altar society, and a member of the American Legion Women's Auxiliary where she was a past president. She was an avid gardener, impeccable card player, determined bowler, and the greatest maker of coconut cream pies. She enjoyed watching her children and grandchildren play sports. Besides her family she was most proud of the GED she earned in 1976 and the number of lives she helped save with her donations of blood.
