

Eugene Kimmi Arrested For Parole Violation

Eugene Kimmi, the ex-husband of murdered rural Horton resident Patricia Kimmi, is free on bond after being arrested for a parole violation.

Brown County Attorney Kevin Hill says Kimmi was arrested Monday for allegedly violating a condition of his probation on a third-offense DUI conviction...(play audio)

Atchison County Sheriff John Calhoon says his department arrested Kimmi early Monday evening on a Brown County warrant...(continue audio: 41 secs)

Kimmi was booked into the Atchison County Jail, but was later released on \$25,000 bond.

Hill says Kimmi is to make his first appearance in Brown County Court April 19th...(continue audio: 17 secs)

It's Kimmi's second arrest for violating terms of his probation.

Last October, a Brown County District Judge revoked Kimmi's probation on the DUI charge after he was found to have violated the conditions by testing positive for alcohol. A blood-alcohol test found a blood-alcohol content of 0.05.

He was sentenced to 12 months probation. However, he was ordered to serve 60 days in the Brown County Jail as a condition of the probation.

Kimmi was originally sentenced in October 2010 to 12 months in jail on the charge. He became eligible for probation after serving 90 days of that sentence. As a condition of probation, Kimmi was forbidden from consuming any alcohol.
