Hiawatha Teen Pleads No Contest to Child Sex Charges

A Hiawatha teenager has been convicted on a pair of sex offenses involving a child under the age of 14.

18-year-old Dylan Dodge pleaded no contest today (Monday) in Brown County District Court to one count each of aggravated indecent liberties with a child and aggravated solicitation of a child. The charges were contained in amended complaint filed by Brown County Attorney Kevin Hill. Dodge had originally been charged with a single count of aggravated indecent liberties with a child born in 1997.

Dodge was arrested last September following an investigation by the Brown County Sheriff's Department.

His bond was revoked today (Monday) and he was remanded to the Brown County Jail pending sentencing on May 21st.
