Southeast Golf Team in Contention Midway Through National Tourney

The Southeast Community College Men's Golf Team is in third place mid-way through the NJCAA Division 2 National Tournament. The Storm followed Monday's 294 total with a 297 on Tuesday, putting them at plus-15 591 after two rounds of the four-round tournament. John A. Logan College is second at plus-13, and South Mountain Community College of Arizona leads the tournament at plus-2 578. Southeast was in a five-way tie for first following Monday's first round.
