Fairfax Man Injured in Crash near Quitman

Two people were taken to the hospital in Maryville following a two-vehicle accident near Quitman in rural Nodaway County Missouri Tuesday evening.

The accident happened shortly after 5:00 p.m. Tuesday at the intersection of Missouri Route 113 and 210th Avenue, about two miles north of Quitman.

According to the State Patrol, 47-year-old Timothy Cherry of Fairfax was driving a Toyota pickup north on Route 113 when his vehicle was struck by a westbound Pontiac Sunfire that had failed to stop at a stop sign and had pulled into the path of Cherry's pickup.
