Missouri State Patrol Seeks Recruits

The Missouri State Highway Patrol is encouraging qualified individuals to apply to become troopers. The testing procedure includes a written exam, a physical assessment, polygraph test, background investigation, and oral interview. Applicants also must successfully complete a medical exam, psychological examination, and drug screening.
