Planning Commissioners Deny Turbine Variance

Atchison Planning Commissioners unanimously deny a variance for the construction of three wind turbines in a field near Atchison city limits Wednesday afternoon.

Michael Binder told Commissioners in the public hearing that his turbines imported from China were very strong and away from homes and businesses.

Commissioners cited concern that Binder's turbines did not have stamped plans from a licensed engineer.

Denton made his pitch for the variance prior to vote.
