Plat Not Recommended for Atchison Subdivision Atchison Planning Commissioners failed to recommend approval to City Commissioners to subdivide five lots south of Atchison.

Commissioners voted three to three against the Saint Francis Subdivision, which is one point five miles south of Atchison Hospital.

Joe Herring of Herring Surveying Company of Leavenworth was responsible for the subdivision and said this would be the largest subdivision in Atchison County.
