Wildcats, Jayhawks headline Hall of Fame class Wichita, Kan. (AP) - Former Kansas State quarterback Michael Bishop and former Kansas basketball star Bud Stallworth are among the nine members of the 2012 class of Kansas Sports Hall of Fame.

Bishop was the runner-up for the Heisman Trophy in 1998, setting several school records along the way. Stallworth was the Big Eight player of the year in 1972.

Kurt Budke, the Oklahoma State women's basketball coach who died in a plane crash last year, will be inducted posthumously during the ceremony Oct. 7th in Wichita.

Budke is orginially from Salina, Kan. and played basketball at Washburn.

Other members of the class include former Kansas quarterback David Jaynes and basketball player Wayne Simien; Kansas State basketball player Willie Murrell; Olympian Harold Manning; longtime tennis coach David Snyder and softball player Brenda Stolle.
