Three Area Lakes Under Public Health Advisory

(KNZA)--Two additional area lakes have been placed under a "Public Health Advisory" due to the threat of toxic blue green algae.

The Kansas Department of Health and Environment says the Atchison State Fishing Lake and Centralia Lake in Nemaha County join the Brown County State Fishing Lake under an advisory status.

The Brown County lake was placed under the advisory last week.

KDHE says water activities like boating and fishing may be safe. However, direct contact with the water—such as wading and swimming—is strongly discouraged for people, pets and livestock. Fish from the lakes should be cleaned and rinsed with clean water, and only the fillet portion eaten. KDHE will continue to monitor the situation.
