Nemaha Co. Ks Agrees to Setback Requirements for Wind Turbines (KMZA)-- Nemaha County (Ks) will establish setbacks requirements for wind turbines built in the county.

County commissioners agreed Monday to have the county attorney draw up a resolution requiring that wind turbines be located three thousand feet from homes and 15-hundred feet from property lines.

A group of residents in the northeast portion of the county had requested that the county establish setback requirements, concerned about the noise a proposed wind farm in the area would create.
