Nemaha County Commission Adopts 2013 Budget

(KMZA)-- The Nemaha County (KS) Commission has adopted the 2013 budget as published, which calls for a slight decrease in the property tax levy.

The action followed a hearing Monday drawing no comment.

The \$13.2 million budget contains an estimated tax rate of 50.520 mills, which is expected to generate nearly \$6.3 million in tax revenue.

The commission was able to lower the mill levy due to an increase in the county's assessed valuation.
