Nemaha Co. Commission Approves Computer Purchase

(KMZA)-- The Nemaha County appraiser's office will be getting several new computers.

County Appraiser Betty Roeder came before Nemaha County Commissioners Monday to request to purchase new computers for her office.

Roeder said that the GIS computer needs to be replaced and she would also like to replace two PC's in her office used by her staff.

In addition, Roeder said she would like all her staff members to have dual monitors for their computers.

She presented price quotes from Dell for the purchase of three new computers and three extra monitors at a total cost \$4,063.
