Governor to Participate in Statewide Food Drive Kick-Off

Governor Brownback will help launch the Neighbor to Neighbor statewide food drive Monday, February 18, at 3:30 p.m. at Harvesters – The Community Food Network, at 215 SE Quincy, Topeka, KS 66603.

The month-long food drive to reduce hunger in Kansas is jointly hosted by the Kansas Department of Agriculture, Dillon's Food Stores, Harvesters – The Community Food Network, the Kansas Food Bank, the Second Harvest Community Food Bank and the Kansas agricultural community. The campaign will culminate on Kansas Agriculture Day, March 19.
