Jay Hurla with 360 Energy made a presentation Wednesday afternoon profiling the cost savings Atchison Senior Village will have as a result of energy upgrades.

Hurla says 360 started with Senior Village's analysis about a year and a half ago, which led to replacement of their boilers, one of which was over 50 years old.
