Branch Street Project Work Starts Tuesday in Seneca (KMZA)--Major delays are unlikely despite new intersection installation work set to begin Tuesday in Seneca.

The project will mean lane restrictions for both eastbound and westbound traffic on U.S. Highway 36, from 11th Street to Community Drive.

The intersection will built halfway between 11th and Community, at a new roadway to be named Fairway Drive, along with the addition of a left turn lane on U.S. 36 for the new intersection.
