### Info Sought on Theft of More than 56K Worth of Items

(KMZA )--The Pottawatomie County Sheriff's Office is investigating the theft of more than \$56,000 worth of landscaping supplies and equipment from a Manhattan business.

Sheriff Greg Riat says numerous items were allegedly taken from Flint Hills Landscape between September 13th of last year and March 17th of this year.

You can find a list of the missing items posted below. Riat says some of the items taken were marked with a small Flint Hills Landscape decal.
