Nemaha County Nebraska Assessor Resigns

Applications and a resume along with a copy of a valid certification as Assessor is due to the County Clerk's Office by January 30, with interviews expected to be conducted February 4.

Authorization was also given to hire a part-time / temporary employees for the Assessors office during the transition period.

Bids were opened for an excavator. Bids were received from three companies ranging from \$190,000 to \$193,850. The Board will review the bids and expects to award a bid January 28th.
