Segments are: a half-mile run/walk/jog or a 5 mile bike ride. A minimum fundraising donation of \$1000 is required per regular segment per team and \$2500 per premium segment per team. A team consists of up to 15 people. For every \$1500 raised, teams will receive a commemorative torch.
