

One Injured in Wreck South of Holton

**(KNZA)--A two-vehicle wreck about five miles south of Holton Thursday morning sent one person to the hospital.**

**The Kansas Highway Patrol says it happened around 6:45 at the intersection of U.S. 75 Highway and 190th Road.**

**The Patrol says a sport-utility vehicle driven by 21-year-old Mayetta resident Chaz Shopteese was westbound crossing Highway 75 when his vehicle was struck by a southbound semi.**

**Shopteese was transported to Topeka's Stormont-Vail hospital for the treatment of what Jackson County Sheriff Tim Morse described as disabling injuries.**

**The semi driver from Philadelphia, Pennsylvania was not hurt.**

**The Patrol says both drivers were wearing seatbelts.**
