

FCPD busy during Click It or Ticket campaign

(KLZA)-- The Falls City Police Department made 28 traffic stops, issuing 16 citations and a dozen warnings during the November 23 - 27 Click it or ticket mobilization.

In addition, officers responded to 38 calls for service with two traffic accidents reported. One warrant arrest was made, eight reports of child abuse/neglect were investigated along with three reports of 3rd degree assault and one report of sexual abuse and two reports of vandalism, five disturbance reports and one report of domestic violence.

The overtime cost associated with the mobilization was funded by a grant provided by the Nebraska Department of Transportation, Highway Safety Office.
