

Johnson-Brock School Board approves budget with 14% decrease in property taxes
(KLZA)-- The Johnson-Brock School Board conducted public hearings on the proposed General Fund Budget and the Property Tax Resolution for the 2023-24 fiscal year when they met last week.

During the regular Board meeting the Board approved a total budget of \$6,100,903 which is a decrease of \$162,332.

The property tax request will be 54.722 cents per \$100 of assessed valuation which represent a 14 percent decrease from last year. The total property tax request will amount to \$2,816,303.

Johnson-Brock Board members also voted to recognize the Johnson-Brock Education Association as the collective bargaining agent for the teachers for the 2024-25 school year.

The purchase of a 2018 Transtech 14 passenger school bus was approved and the Board approved the appointment of Mike Casey and Bruce Sohnholz to three-year terms on the Johnson-Brock Foundation Board.
