Auburn Residents Face Drug Charges Following Sunday Search

Two Auburn residents face drug-related charges, after Auburn Police executed a search warrant at a residence in the 1100 block of 17th Street Sunday evening.

Police Chief Kris Baker says officers located and seized marijuana, methamphetamine, and other items commonly associated with the sale and distribution of controlled substances during the search at 1118 17th Street.

methamphetamine, possession of a controlled substance with the intent to deliver, and possession of drug money.
