Three Charged with Attempting to Sell Stolen Guns Appear in Court

Three people accused of attempting to sell stolen firearms made appearances in Richardson County Court Monday.

Judge Curtis Maschman found probable cause to detain 20-year-old Travis Ries of Pawnee City. He faces felony charges of possessing or receiving a stolen firearm and possession of a firearm by a prohibited person. Bond was continued at 10-percent of \$10,000.

A preliminary hearing was scheduled for 18-year-old Robert Luallin and 17-year-old Breanna Swanson. Luallin is charged with a class 3 felony of possessing or receiving a stolen firearm. Swanson faces a charge of aiding and abetting a class 3 felony.

Preliminary hearings for Ries, Luallin, and Swanson were set for March 26th.

Authorities say they attempted to sell two stolen guns to a Humboldt woman this past January.
